#### Some highlights from our learning this week:

**Nursery:** We have been learning about the number 3 and exploring different ways of making 3 e.g. 2 and 1.

**Reception:** This week, the children have been focusing on the numbers 6,7 and 8. They have been counting out different objects and matching the number to the correct quantity.

**Year 1:** In Year 1, we have been learning place value for numbers to 20.

**Year 2:** Our unit this term is money. The children have been learning how to make amounts using pounds and pence.

**Year 3:** Year 3 have been learning about the inverse relationship between multiplication and division.

**Year 4:** We started off the week discussing the terms 'product', 'factors' and 'factor pairs'. We worked collaboratively to find as many of factor pairs as we could for a particular number. We did this by making arrays with counters.



**Year 5:** Year 5 have been focusing on short division. They have been using the bus stop method to calculate division problems that are presented to them in a range of different contexts.

**Year 6:** We have tackled algebra and in Year 6 this year which has been a challenging concept to master! The children have shown excellent determination to improve.

**DSP:** In math this week the KS1 children have been learning about number bonds to 10.

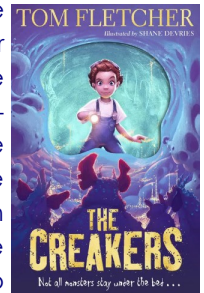
