### Some highlights from our learning this week: Maths!

**EYFS:** In Maths, we are learning about number bonds to 10.

**Year 1:** In Maths next week, we will be using symbols to compare numbers to 50 using greater than, less than and equal to.

**Year 2:** Year 2 have just started learning about fractions, learning how a fraction must be split into equal parts.

**Year 3:** Year 3 have been finding a fraction of a shape and relating this to measurements! We will then move on to mass and capacity.

**Year 4:** Year 4 have been learning all about perimeter. We are moving on to calculating the perimeter of rectilinear shapes and of polygons.

**Year 5:** Year 5 are moving onto percentages and understanding how they relate to fractions and decimals.

**Year 6:** Year 6 have been finding out how to calculate unknown angles in on straight lines, around a point and in a range of shapes.
