Some highlights from our learning this week: Science!

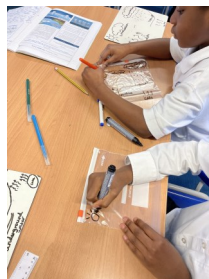
EYFS: In EYFS, we labelled flowers and created flowers using playdough.



Year 1: We have been sorting animals into different groups.

Year 2: Year 2 went on a walk around the school and looked for different materials. We thought about their uses and what properties they have.

Year 3: Year 3 have been comparing the difference between human and animal skeletal systems.



Year 4: Year 4 have been learning about the Water Cycle and have made their own using reusable food bags!

Year 5: We have been learning about reversible and irreversible changes. We conducted an investigation where we mixed vinegar and milk to create a new substance.

Year 6: Within our topic on evolution and inheritance, we have been explaining how different animals have adapted to suit their environment in order to survive.
